SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- June 2021

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: Effluent flows: 34.56 million gallons were treated during June. The highest Daily flow was 1.42 million gallons on the 15th and the lowest flow was 0.91 million gallons on the 6th. The average flow was 1.15 million gallons. Total rainfall for June was 2.08 inches. 558.25 Yards were spread on City owned Property for beneficial use in June.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 4,349,000 gallons on June 27th.
- **Water System** Replaced 10 water meters and 3 meter boxes. Repaired service at 1594 6th Ave, and repaired 1" main on E Cedar. Conducted leak detection survey of East side of town.
- **Streets** Swept 120 curb miles and 21 cubic yards of material was collected. Replaced 3 street name signs.
- **Parks** None for June 2021.
