SUBJECT: Public Works Monthly Operating Report- May 2023

KEY ACTIVITIES

STATUS

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 40.1 million gallons were treated during May. The highest Daily flow was 1.63 million gallons on the 1st and 2nd and the lowest flow was 0.97 million gallons on the 23rd. The average flow was 1.29 million gallons. Total rainfall for May was .61 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in May.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,264,000 gallons on May 19, 2023.
- **Water System** Replaced 13 meters. Replaced 10 meter boxes and 10 water service lines.
- **Streets** Swept 40 curb miles and 15 cubic yards of material was collected.
- **Parks** French Drain installed at Northslope Park.
