**KEY ACTIVITIES**

**STATUS**

- **WWTP Facility** Effluent flows: 31.44 million gallons were treated during October. The highest Daily flow was 1.32 million gallons on the 26th and the lowest flow was 0.88 million gallons on the 1st. The average flow was 1.01million gallons. Total rainfall for October was 1.91 inches. No bio solids were hauled off site in October.
- **WTP** Highest production day was 3,172,000 gallons on October 25, 2022.
- **Water System** Replaced 12 meters. Replaced 1 meter box.
- **Streets** Swept 447 curb miles and 54 cubic yards of material was collected.
- **Parks** None for October 2022.
