OMNINANCE No. 222

AN ORDINANCE providing for improvement of the Town of Stayton Park; providing an appropriation therefor; authorizing acceptance of U. S. Government aid; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Town of Stayton, Oregon, is owner of a tract of land situated at the east end of Marion Street, which was intended as a public park and recreation center, but which is unimproved; and

WHEREAS, the U.S. Ggvernment, through the Works Progress Administration has allocated and offered to the Town the sum of \$5404.00 for labor costs for the improvement of such park:

THE TOWN OF STATTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- Sec. 1. That the public park property owned by the fown of Stayton and situated at the east end of Marion Street therein, be improved by landscaping, the state of the state o
- Sec. 2. That all of such work shall be done as the Council may from time to time direct, and the Council shall exercise general supervision over the same, and may retain such person or persons as it may find necessary for the direct supervision of the work.
- Sec. 3. That there be, and hereby is appropriated from the general funds of the Town of Stayton, not otherwise appropriated, a sum not to exceed \$1142.00 for payment of costs of materials, equipment, and supervision for such work.
- Sec. 4. That the offer of the U.S. Government to furnish, through the W.P.A., the sum of \$5404.00 to be used for labor costs in such work, be, and the same hereby is accepted, and the Mayor, Recorder, and/or Treasurer, are hereby authorized to enter into the necessary agreement with such agency.
- Sec. 5. That inasmuch as the terms of such W. P. A. offer require such work to commence immediately, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately following it's passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
