

ORDINANCE No. 230

AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 6 of Ordinance No. 229, of the Town of Stayton, providing for the numbering of structures within said Town; and declaring an emergency.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 229, which Ordinance was passed by the Council of the Town of Stayton on April 3, 1939, and approved by the Mayor thereof on said date, be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 6. All numbers shall be placed on the front of each structure as near the main entrance as possible, in such manner as to be easily seen and read from the public way.

The type of numbers used shall be as determined by the Council, and it shall be unlawful for any person to use any type of number unless the same shall have the approval of the Council.

On each structure numbered, the numbers shall be placed in a manner approved by the Council, and the work of placing the numbers may be paid for out of Town funds, at the option of the Council.

The cost of the numbers used may be paid for out of Town funds, or a charge therefor may be levied against the owner or occupant of each structure numbered, at the option of the Council."

Section 2. Inasmuch as provisions have been made for the numbering of buildings pursuant to the ordinance, and a delay will occur if this ordinance be not passed, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
