

Ordinance No. 238

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION FOURTEEN OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 213 $\frac{1}{2}$ FIXING THE HOURS WITHIN WHICH ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS MAY BE SOLD.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 14 of Ordinance No. 213 $\frac{1}{2}$ which was passed by the Council of the Town of Stayton, Oregon, on May 7, 1934, and approved by the Mayor thereof on May 14, 1934, be, and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 14. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell any alcoholic liquor within the Town of Stayton between the hours of one o'clock A. M. and five o'clock A. M. of any day, or at any other time when the sale thereof is prohibited by any law of the State of Oregon, and it shall likewise be unlawful for any establishment where alcoholic liquors are sold to remain open during said restricted hours.
