

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN TRADES AND BUSINESSES;
PROVIDING THE AMOUNT OF LICENSE TO BE PAID; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR
VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Town of Stayton do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The trades and businesses herein after set out shall pay the license fees provided herein.

One ringed circus	\$20.00 daily
Two ringed circus	30.00 "
Three ringed circus	50.00 "
Each side show	5.00 "
Tent shows	20.00 "
Dog and pony shows	5.00 "
Street shows upon the street or public places, patent medicine, or other things sold on street	10.00 "
Public roundup or rodeo	50.00 "
Any game or amusement, as merry-go-round, ring or ball throwing, or other similar game	10.00 "
Bowling alley or shooting gallery	20.00 Year
	10.00 half year
Traveling shows in theatres or public hall	3.00 daily
	15.00 weekly

Section 2. Any person, firm, company or corporation desiring to engage in any business or occupation for which a license is required by section 1 of this ordinance shall make application in writing to the city recorder setting forth the name of the applicant, nature of the business, the place where such business shall be conducted, and such other information as may be required by said recorder.

Section 3. Upon the filing of the application and the payment of license fee, the recorder shall issue such license setting forth the amount paid, the nature of the business licensed, the time said license is to run, the place where said business is to be conducted and the name and address of the licensee.

Section 4. In every case where more than one trade or business for which a license is required by this ordinance shall be conducted or carried on in the same place by the same person, firm, company or corporation at the same time, a license shall be taken out for each of said pursuits according to the rates severally prescribed herein.

Section 5. Any person, firm, company, or corporation, or any agent or officer of any firm, company, or corporation who shall pursue any trade or business herein enumerated without first taking out a license as herein provided, or violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than \$5 nor more than \$50, or by imprisonment for not less than 2 days nor more than 20 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.
