

ORDINANCE

297

AN ORDINANCE PERMITTING THE CITY COUNCIL TO CONTROL AND REGULATE THE DISTRIBUTION OF ANY COMMODITY BY CONDUIT OR PIPELINE WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON

The Town of Stayton does ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION I. No person, firm, company or corporation shall hereafter construct or lay any pipeline, conduits or other appurtenances thereto in excess of 200 feet within the city and corporate limits of the Town of Stayton.

SECTION II. That the Town of Stayton shall have the sole and exclusive right to issue permits or franchises. When a permit or franchise is granted it shall not be transferable or assignable to any person, company, corporation or firm without having said person, company, corporation or firm who is to be the assignee qualify as the assignor did in the beginning.

SECTION III. The Common Council of the Town of Stayton has the right to make all necessary and reasonable regulations as a condition precedent to any person, firm, company or corporation being allowed to lay or construct any pipeline or conduit for the transfer of any and all commodities, within the corporate limits of the Town of Stayton.
