

ORDINANCE NO. 918

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ANNEXATION REQUIREMENTS OF STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE, TITLE 17

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 197 requires municipalities to adopt and implement a comprehensive land use planning program in accordance with statewide planning goals established by the Legislature and the Oregon Land Conservation and Development Commission;

WHEREAS, Title 17, Land Use and Development, of the Stayton Municipal Code (SMC), currently contains a requirement that applications from property owners to have three or more acres of land annexed into the City Limits must be approved by the voters;

WHEREAS, the Revised City Charter approved by the voters and effective January 1, 2010 requires voter approval of annexations of one acre or more except those required by state law;

WHEREAS, following a public hearing, the Stayton Planning Commission has unanimously recommended that the Stayton City Council enact a proposed amendment to bring Title 17 into compliance with the new Charter; and,

WHEREAS, following a public hearing, the Stayton City Council deems that the proposed amendments comply with the Charter of the City of Stayton.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Stayton ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Stayton Municipal Code, Title 17, Section 17.12.210.2.a.1)ii is hereby amended to read,

- ii. The area proposed for annexation exceeds ~~3 acres~~ 1 acre, except a health hazard annexation.

SECTION 2. Stayton Municipal Code, Title 17, Section 17.12.210.2.b.1)ii is hereby amended to read,

- ii. The area proposed for annexation is ~~3 acres~~ 1 acre or less.

SECTION 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after adoption by the Stayton City Council and the Mayor's signing.

SECTION 4. A copy of this Ordinance shall be furnished to the State of Oregon, Department of Land Conservation and Development forthwith.


