

ORDINANCE NO. 823

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CITY OF STAYTON ORDINANCE NO. 821 AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 678, BOTH RELATING TO STATEWIDE MEASURE NO. 7; AND, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council adopted Ordinance No. 821 to accommodate the implementation of the Oregon statewide Measure No. 7 which, subsequent to the adoption of Ordinance No. 821, was enjoined from becoming effective by the Marion County Oregon Circuit Court;

WHEREAS, in conjunction with Ordinance No. 821, the Council adopted Resolution No. 678, specifying cost schedules, et al.;

WHEREAS, until the state law on the subject is resolved through the Court or otherwise, it is appropriate that Stayton's related legislation be repealed;

WHEREAS, because the statewide Measure 7's implementation has been rendered, at least temporarily, ineffective, it is appropriate that the Stayton legislation and resolution be promptly repealed/rescinded; and,

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that an emergency be declared as to the enactment of this Ordinance so that it is in full force and effect immediately from and after its adoption by the Stayton City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE the Stayton City Council does ordain as follows:

- SECTION 1.: City of Stayton Ordinance No. 821 is hereby repealed.
- SECTION 2.: City of Stayton Resolution No. 678 is rescinded.
- SECTION 3.: Upon adoption by the Stayton City Council and the Mayor's signing, this Ordinance shall become immediately effective.
