#### **ORDINANCE NO. 893**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 881 TO ACCURATELY DESCRIBE LAND BEING ANNEXED INTO THE CITY OF STAYTON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on June 20, 2005, the Stayton City Council enacted Ordinance No. 881, annexing certain property along the North Bank of the North Santiam River into the City boundaries and amending the City of Stayton's Comprehensive Plan and Zone Maps;

WHEREAS, the Oregon Department of Revenue has determined that are inaccuracies in the property description and map that were attached to Ordinance No. 881;

WHEREAS, a revised property description and map have been prepared and are attached to this ordinance as Exhibit "B"; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that an emergency be declared as to the enactment of this Ordinance so that it is in full force and effect immediately from and after its adoption by the Stayton City Council and signing by the Mayor.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Stayton Ordinance No. 881 is hereby amended by deleting its description of "Property B" in its entirety and substituting the attached property description and by inserting the attached map showing the revised description of Property B.

SECTION 2. An emergency is declared to exist to resolve confusion which may result among various governmental units as to the correct boundaries of the City of Stayton. Upon adoption by the Stayton City Council and the Mayor's signing, this Ordinance shall become immediately effective.


