ORDINANCE NO. 757

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.04.010, "MEETINGS."

- WHEREAS, Stayton Municipal Code Section 2.04.010 indicates that meetings of the Stayton City Council in regular session shall convene at 7:30 p.m.; and
- WHEREAS, members of the Stayton City Council find that, due to the weight and/or nature of the business to come before the council, or for other considerations the council may deem appropriate, 7:30 p.m. may not be the optimal meeting time; and
- WHEREAS, Rules of the Stayton City Council (Resolution No. 486), Section 1., "Meetings," specifies that the council shall meet in regular session "at 7:30 p.m. unless another time is designated"; and
- WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council desires to designate the time of convening regular sessions as indicated in the Rules of Council;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Stayton City Council hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION 1: That Stayton Municipal Code Section 2.04.010, "Meetings," is hereby amended to read:

2.04.010 MEETINGS

- 1. The regular meetings of the council shall be held on the first and third Mondays of each month at a time designated by the council and set in council policy, in the Community Center, 400 W. Virginia, Stayton, Oregon, or another specified location in the city. If the regular meeting day falls upon a legal holiday, the regular meeting shall be held the following day at a time and place to be determined by the mayor.
- 2. Special meetings of the city council shall be held when called by the mayor or when three city councilors request that the mayor call a special meeting. Notice of special meetings, including the subject, time, and place of the meeting, shall be given to all councilors then in the city.

Public notice of the special meetings shall be given to the news media and interested persons and posted at Stayton City Hall twenty-four (24) hours prior to the meeting. In case of an actual emergency, a special meeting may be called and public notice given three (3) hours prior to the meeting.

3. Meetings which have been recessed may be reconvened at such times as the council may determine.
