

ORDINANCE No. 614

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING A PORTION OF ORDINANCE No. 607 AND WITHDRAWING CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM THE SUBLIMITY RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT BECAUSE THAT PROPERTY HAS BEEN ANNEXED INTO THE CITY OF STAYTON, MARION COUNTY, OREGON

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton's City Council conducted a public hearing considering an annexation petition for certain property described in Attachment "A" and, after due consideration, approved the annexation by Ordinance No. 579 dated December 20, 1982; and,

WHEREAS, after conducting a public hearing and considering all objections or remonstrances with regard to the proposed withdrawal of the above-referenced property from the Sublimity Rural Fire Protection District because that property has been annexed into the City of Stayton and the City Council finding that withdrawal is in the best interest of the City,

NOW THEREFORE,


THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Part of District Withdrawn. The property described in Attachment "A" has been annexed into the City and is hereby proclaimed to be withdrawn from the Sublimity Rural Fire Protection District.


Section 2. Record. The City Administrator shall submit to the Oregon Secretary of State a copy of this Ordinance. Notice of this Ordinance shall also be sent to the Marion County Assessor, County Clerk and the State Department of Revenue within ten (10) days of the effective date.

ATTACHMENT "A"

All that portion of the South one-half of the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 3, Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon, and the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of said Section lying South of the Santiam Highway.

SAVE AND EXCEPT that part conveyed to the State of Oregon and to Northwest Wood Products, Inc., an Oregon Corporation, the former being by decree of the Circuit Court of Oregon for Marion County, being suit #42775 and the latter by deed recorded November 24, 1969, in Book 675, Page 50 Deed Records.

Subject to the rights of the public in and to that portion of the herein described premises lying within the limits of roads and roadways.

Further subject to access restrictions set out in decree dated July 11, 1956, in Circuit Court Suit #42775, Marion County, Oregon.
