ORDINANCE NO. 620

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE SECTION RELATING TO UTILITY DEPOSITS.

WHEREAS, the current City Code Section relating to utility deposits treats renters differently from property owners and the City Council has determined that the treatment should be equal,

NOW THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.135 of the Stayton City Code is amended to to read:

5.135 Utility Deposits - When Required

- 1. A utility deposit of \$30.00, or an amount equal to three (3) times the estimated monthly utility bill, whichever is greater, shall be required of all persons requesting utility service at any premises.
- 2. Such deposit shall be held as security for the payment of any account to become owing for water use by such customer, and any part or all of such deposit may be applied at any time toward the payment of any delinquent amount. (463)
