

ORDINANCE NO. 673

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE OREGON CRIMINAL CODE, PROHIBITIONS RELATING TO LIQUOR, AND THE UNIFORM CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES ACT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: STAYTON CITY CODE SECTION 9.04.010 is hereby adopted to read:

9.04.010 STATUTES ADOPTED

- A. The Oregon Criminal Code, Prohibitions Relating to Liquor, and the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, as codified in the Oregon Revised Statutes, 1986, and as amended by the 1985 Legislature, are hereby adopted.
- B. Violations of these provisions shall be an offense against the City and the procedures therein provided, insofar as possible, apply to the City except as modified in this title.

SECTION 2: SAVING CLAUSE

When all or part of the Oregon Criminal Code, Prohibitions Relating to Liquor, or the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, are amended or repealed, the part(s) thereof so amended or repealed shall remain in force for the purpose of authorizing the accusation, prosecution, conviction, and punishment of a person in violation of the Code, Prohibitions, Act, or part thereof before the effective date of the amending or repealing ordinance.


SECTION 3:

IT IS HEREBY ADJUDGED AND DECLARED, that existing conditions in the City of Stayton are such that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health, safety, and general welfare of the City and the inhabitants thereof, and an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance shall be in

full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.


