

ORDINANCE NO. 415

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE OREGON CRIMINAL CODE OF 1971

The City of Stayton do ordain as follows:


Section I. Chapter 743, Oregon Laws, 1971, known as the Oregon Criminal Code of 1971, is hereby adopted in its entirety.

Section II. If any section or sections of said code are hereafter declared to be invalid, unconstitutional or unenforceable as regards the City of Stayton or the jurisdiction of the municipal court, it shall not affect any other section of said code.

Section III. The Council finding that an emergency exists and the adoption of said code is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public safety, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
