

ORDINANCE NO. 416

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 399
RELATING TO WATER SYSTEM RATES

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS :


Section 1. Subsection 3 of Section V of Ordinance No. 399 of the City of Stayton, enacted September 14, 1970, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3. The rates under this section are based on multiple residential or commercial units having separate meters as required by Section XV of this ordinance. In the event any such multiple units do not have separate meters, the rates shall be calculated by the water board as if separate meters were installed, (\$3.00 per month residential, \$4.00 per month commercial, 5,000 gallons minimum per month per unit) with usage over the minimum averaged over the units. Any customer having large differences in usage between such unmetered units may request Council review of the rates set by the board or may install separate meters upon payment of the hookup fee."

Section 2. This ordinance being necessary to provide uniform rates and to furnish revenue for the municipal water system, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after February 21, 1972.
