ORDINANCE NO. 432

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE IN THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 424; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 349; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Stayton do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The rates to be charged all persons, firms, or corporations shall be reasonable and uniform, taking into consideration the service rendered and shall not be in excess of the following schedule:

Special Rates:

Unconfined wastes, a charge based on one man and one truck, \$17.00 per hour; and \$22.00 per hour two men and one truck; time being based portal to portal. An additional reasonable charge may be made for unusual services not included in the schedule as agreed by the parties. Such charge will not discriminate against any customer or class of customers. White goods, including, but not limited to, appliances, water heaters and similar items, \$2.00 collection charge plus the cost of disposal.

An occasional extra can, or the equivalent thereof, for regular customers on a regular route, \$0.65. Occasional type customer not on a regular route, \$1.00 minimum charge.

Section 2. The commercial and residential rates specified in Section 1 of this ordinance are based on government regulations requiring weekly service for putricible solid wastes. The rates are based on a per unit charge for each residential unit or commercial establishment.

Section 3. So long as these rates remain in effect, the franchise holder shall be permitted to adopt reasonable rules, with prior written approval of the chairman of the solid waste committee, for the pick up of solid wastes on the driveway, curb or elsewhere, although special consideration shall be given for aged or infirm persons, and the maximum rates described herein shall not prohibit the franchise holder from billing in advance.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 424, enacted August 21, 1972, is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Section 11 of Ordinance No. 349 is hereby amended to read:

"Section 11. The rates to be charged for hauling garbage shall be as contained in Ordinance No. 432 of the City of Stayton or as amended."

Section 6. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
