

ORDINANCE NO. 480

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON ON June 7, 1977, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL ELECTORS OF THE CITY A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A LEVY BY THE CITY OF A TAX IN THE SUM OF \$251,507.56 OUTSIDE THE CONSTITUTIONAL LIMITATIONS FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE GENERAL FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Stayton, Oregon, has determined that a tax levy should be established as authorized by Section II, Article XI, Oregon Constitution for the tax year 1977-78, to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of departments of the General Fund.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of tax in excess of the six per cent (6%) constitutional limitations in the form of a tax levy.

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Date of Election. The proposition set forth in Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed herein to the legal voters of the City of Stayton, Oregon, at a Special City Election to be held on June 7, 1977.

Section 2. Form of Proposition. At the Special Election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"Shall the City of Stayton be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of Two Hundred Fifty One Thousand Five Hundred Seven Dollars and Fifty Six Cents (\$251,507.56) outside the limitation imposed by Section II, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1977-78, to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of departments of the General Fund?"

Section 3. Election Procedure. The election shall be conducted under the provisions of Section 25 of the Charter of the City of Stayton. The polling places for said election shall be open from the hours of 8:00 O'Clock A.M. to 8:00 O'Clock P.M. on said day and that the City Recorder is instructed to take to the polling places, booths, pens, pencils, ballots and poll books for the purpose of providing for said election.

Section 4. Notice of Election. Notice of the special election shall be given by posting notice thereof in at least five public places within the City of Stayton, not less than ten days prior to the election, not more than thirty days prior thereto, and by publication thereof twice in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Stayton, Oregon, not more than thirty days nor less than ten days prior to the election. The notices shall be in substantially the following form:

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

On June 7, 1977, in the City of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, from 8:00 A.M. until 8:00 P.M., a Special City Election. Will be held at which the following proposition will be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Stayton for their approval or rejection:

ESTABLISHING A TAX LEVY. Shall the City of Stayton be authorized to levy a tax on property in the sum of Two Hundred Fifty One Thousand Five Hundred Seven Dollars and Fifty Six Cents (\$251,507.56) outside the limitation by Section II, Article XI, Oregon Constitution, for the tax year 1977-78, to provide funds for the operation and maintenance of departments of the General Fund. YES / NO /

If this proposition is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax year 1977-78 will be \$85,094.56 more than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the proceeding year.

The polling places for said election in the City of Stayton shall be as follows:




