

ORDINANCE NO. 306

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAMES OF CERTAIN STREETS IN THE TOWN OF STAYTON, MARION COUNTY, OREGON AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, The Town of Stayton, acting by and through its Common Council has made a study of the names of various streets and wanting to eliminate confusion and to set a worded system rather than letters, for the convenience of the Town of Stayton;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON:

Section 1. The following named streets in the Town of Stayton which are hereinafter listed, hereby are changed from the present existing names and alphabetical letters as set forth hereinafter, to the new names hereinafter set opposite the presently existing names as follows, to-wit:

Section 2. That said Ordinance to change the names is made subject to the designation of the sections of the Town of Stayton in which the respective streets or future streets are located, and also is subject to the designation indicating the general direction in which said streets run, and is subject to the numbering of the buildings and residences located thereon.

Section 3. All streets running North and South be designated as "Avenues" and streets running East and West be designated as "Streets".

Section 4. Inasmuch as the adoption of this ordinance will have an effect upon the delivery of mail within the said city and in order that as much confusion as is possible might be avoided, it is hereby considered that the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary for the health, peace, safety and welfare of the Town of Stayton, Oregon and of its inhabitants and an emergency hereby is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
