## ORDINANCE NO. 314

AN ORDINANCE amending Chapter 1., Section 1 of the Charter of the Town of Stayton, changing the present name of the "Town of Stayton" to the City of Stayton", and for the calling of an election to be held in the Town of Stayton at the Primary Election on May 18th, 1962, submitting such Ordinance to the registered voters of the Town of Stayton for their approval or rejection at said time; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STAYTON, OREGON

Section 1. That the Common Council is hereby authorized to amend Chapter 1, Section 1. of the Charter of the Town of Stayton, changing the present name of the "Town of Stayton" to the "City of Stayton".

Section 2. This Ordinance is submitted to the registered voters of the Town of Stayton, for their approval or rejection at the Primary Election to be held on May 18th, 1962.

Section 32 The city attorney hereby is directed to prepare the necessary ballot title under which this ordinance shall be submitted to the registered voters of the said town and the recorder is hereby directed to cause the ballot title to be printed in proper form on the ballot to be used at the said election and to perform all other acts necessary, including posting notices in five (5) public places, including the bulletin board at the City Hall as well as publishing said notices in the Stayton Mail, a newspaper of general circulation for two (2) consecutive publications, said notices to be posted and publications to be completed not less than 10 days nor more than 30 days prior to the date of the election as set forth herein.

Section 4. The Judges and Clerks of Elections serving Precinct No. 176, 177 and 178 within the Town of Stayton, shall be the election board officials for this election called by this ordinance; in the Section 5: The election hereby called shall be held at Precinct No. 176, 177 and 178 and the poll shall be open from 8:00 o'clock A.M. Pacific Standard Time and will continue open until 8:00 o'clock P.M. Pacific Standard Time on said date.

Section 6. The provisions of Ordinance No. 242 of the Town of Stayton and the statutes of Oregon relating to elections shall apply as to any matter not herein specifically provided for.

Section 7. That it is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions in the Town of Stayton are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety; and an emergency hereby is declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
