ORDINANCE	NO.	327

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME OF BELL STREET TO REGIS STREET, ALL LYING WITHIN THE CITY OF STAYTON, COUNTY OF MARION, STATE OF OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS: All streets running East and West are called Streets and all streets running North and South are called Avenues, and

WHEREAS, Bell Street extends in a general easterly-westerly direction, it is deemed for the best interest of the public that said street be changed from Bell Street to Regis Street.

SECTION I. Be it ordained this 3rd day of February, 1964, that henceforth and hereafter East and West Bell Street, now lying within the City of Stayton, County of Marion, State of Oregon shall be changed to East and West Regis Street, and hereafter said street shall be known as East and West Regis Street.

SECTION II. This ordinance is deemed necessary for the immediate protection of the public peace, health and safety, therefore, it is hereby adjudged and declared that an emergency exists in the case of this Ordinance and it shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and its approval by the Mayor.
