

ORDINANCE NO. 328

AN ORDINANCE authorizing and directing the execution and delivery in the name and on behalf of the City of Stayton, Oregon, of a contract with Pacific Power & Light Company, a corporation, providing for the furnishing by said Pacific Power & Light Company to said City of electric lighting service upon the streets, highways, and public places within the corporate limits of said City for a period of ten (10) years from and after the effective date of this ordinance, a copy of the contract so authorized being set forth in this ordinance, and declaring such service essential to the security and welfare of said City and its inhabitants.

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. That the City of Stayton make and enter into a contract with Pacific Power & Light Company, a corporation, providing for the furnishing by said Pacific Power & Light Company to the City of Stayton of electric lighting service for lighting the streets, highways, and public places within the corporate limits of the City of Stayton, for the period of ten (10) years from and after the effective date of this ordinance, which contract shall be approved by the Mayor, sealed with the corporate seal of the City and attested by the City Recorder of the City of Stayton, and shall be in words and figures substantially as follows:

Section 2. It is hereby determined by the Council of the City of Stayton that the lighting service provided for in the contract hereby authorized is necessary to enable said City to provide proper protection for itself and the inhabitants thereof, and is essential to the security and welfare of said City and its inhabitants.

Section 3. The Mayor of the City of Stayton is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver such contract with Pacific Power & Light Company in the name and on behalf of the City of Stayton, and the City Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to affix the seal of said City to said contract and to attest the same, upon execution thereof by the Mayor as herein provided.



The City Council of Stayton, Oregon requests that the following changes be made to the Stayton Street Lighting Program.

Installations

- Convert 44 - 16000 lumen M.V. vertical lights to 21000 lumen @ \$5.00 each per month.
Install 2 - 21000 lumen M.V. horizontal lights at Grade School @ \$7.00 each per month.
Install 1 - 21000 lumen M.V. horizontal light at Shaff Rd. & 1st Ave. @ \$7.00 each per month.
Install 1 - 7000 lumen M.V. on Darby St. @ \$4.00 per month.
Install 6 - 7000 lumen M.V. on Locust St. @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 2 - 7000 lumen M.V. in Green Acres @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 1 - 7000 lumen M.V. at 6th & Washington Sts. @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 3 - 7000 lumen M.V. on West Bell Ave. @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 5 - 7000 lumen M.V. on steel posts at Westown Park @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 1 - 7000 lumen M.V. at Washington & Ida @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 1 - 7000 lumen M.V. at 4th & Jefferson St. @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 1 - 7000 lumen M.V. at 2nd & Florence St. @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 4 - 7000 lumen M.V. on West Washington St. between 1st & Stayton Cannery @ \$4.00 each per month.
Install 9 - 7000 lumen M.V. on West Ida between 1st & Leslie Ave. @ \$4.00 each per month.

Removals

- Remove 1 - 16000 lumen M.V. vertical at 1st & Shaff Rd. @ \$5.00.
Remove 1 - 16000 lumen M.V. vertical light on W. Washington between 1st & N. Douglas Ave. @ \$5.00 each per month.
Remove 1 - 16000 lumen M.V. vertical light on West Ida St. between Leslie & Holly Ave. @ \$5.00 each per month.
Remove 1 - 16000 lumen M.V. vertical light on West Ida St. at Cherry & Ida St. @ \$5.00 each per month.
Remove 1 - 10000 lumen Incand. at 2nd & Florence @ \$3.90 each per month.
Remove 2 - 6000 lumen Incandescent lights on Ida St. at N. Gardner Ave. & N. Fern Ave. @ \$3.50 each per month.
Remove 1 - pole charge at N. Gardner & Ida @ \$1.00 each per month.
Remove 1 - 4000 lumen Incandescent at 4th & Jefferson @ \$2.50 each per month.

- Remove 5 - 1000 lumen Incandescent lights on W. Washington between 1st & Svergreen St.
 @ \$1.00 each per month.
 Remove 4 - 1000 lumen Incandescent lights on W. Ida between 1st & Lealie Ave. @ \$1.00
 each per month.
 Remove 4 - 1000 lumen Incandescent lights on W. Locust & N. Fern @ \$1.00 ea. per month.
 Remove 1 - 1000 lumen Incandescent light at City Park @ \$1.00 each per month.
 Remove 1 - pole charge 4th & Jefferson @ \$1.00 each per month.
 Remove 1 - 1000 lumen Incandescent light at 6th & Washington St. @ \$1.00 per month.

It is the councils understanding that the foregoing changes would result in the following street lighting program for the City of Stayton.

3 - 21000 lumen M.V. horizontal lights @ \$7.00 each per month	\$ 21.00

36 - 7000 lumen M.V. lights @ \$4.00 each per month.	144.00

The above program would provide an increase of 416,000 lumens of lighting to the present program, through the installation of 37 new fixtures, removal of 23 old fixtures and the conversion of 44 - 16000 lumen lights to 21000 lumens.

Total lighting provided from the proposed program would be 1,352,000 lumens, an increase of 416,000 lumens over the existing program or an increase of 44.4% more lighting.

All changes made are in agreement with the engineering proposal submitted to the city council in January, 1963 by Pacific Power & Light Co.
