## ORDINANCE NO. 376

AN ORDINANCE declaring annexed to the City of Stayton, Oregon, certain properties of School District No. 77, Marion County, Oregon, and other owners, contiguous to such city at its Northern boundary.

WHEREAS, on the 18th day of March, 1968, the Council passed Ordinance No. 375, effective on such date, fixing the 15th day of April, 1968 at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. in the evening as the time, and the Council Chambers in the City Hall of the city of Stayton as the place, for a public hearing on the question of annexation to such city of the contiguous territory hereinafter described, and dispensing with the holding of an election within such city to vote on the question of such annexation; and,

WHEREAS, at the time and place fixed for such hearing as aforesaid, of which hearing due and legal notice was given by publication thereof in a newspaper of general circulation in the city of Stayton, once each week for two successive weeks prior to the date of such hearing, and by the posting of such notice in readily legible form in at least four public places in such city for a period of more than two weeks prior to the date of such hearing, such hearing was regularly held and the registered voters of such city were afforded an opportunity to be heard on the question of such amnexation; and,

WHEREAS, no objections to such annexation by any of said registered voters or by any other person was then or at any other time made; and,

WHEREAS, the owners of the contiguous territory hereinafter described did, on the 21st day of February and the 11th day of March, 1968, and prior to the holding of the aforesaid public

hearing, file with the Council their written petitions and consents praying the inclusion of such territory within the corporate limits of the city of Stayton, Oregon; and,

WHEREAS, it appears to the Council that it would be in the public interest if such territory hereinafter described were annexed to the City of Stayton, Oregon, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It hereby is declared that the territory lying contiguous to the city of Stayton, in Marion County, Oregon, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the southeast corner of the Henry Foster Donation Land Claim No. 45 in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon; and running thence South 00° 13' East 4.25 feet to the South line of Section 3 in said Township and Range; thence North 89° 41' West 429.23 feet to the Southwest corner of said Section 3; thence South 89° 45' West, along the South line of Section 4 in said Township and Range, 225.37 feet; thence North 00° 18' West 2100.00 feet to a point in the centerline of Mill Creek; thence South 38° 00' East, along said centerline, 220.00 feet; thence South 47° 09' East, continuing along said center-line of Mill Creek, 715.70 feet; thence South 00° 13' East 1437.00 feet to the point of beginning.

Subject to the rights of the public in and to that portion lying within Market Road No. 85.

ALSO: Beginning at a point in the North line of Market Road No. 85, which point is 25,00 feet North 00° 02' East from the Section corner common to Sections 3,4,9 and 10, in Township 9 South, Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian, Marion County, Oregon; and running thence South 89° 45' West, along the North line of said Market Road, 225.51 feet; thence South 00° 18' East 50.00 feet to a point in the South line of said Market Road No. 85; thence North 89° 45' East, along said South line, 225.23 feet; thence South 89° 41' East, continuing along said South line, 429.32 feet; thence North 00° 13' West 50.00 feet to a point in the North line of said Market Road; thence North 89° 41' West, along said North line, 429.10 feet to the point of beginning.

shall be; and hereby is, annexed to the city of Stayton, Oregon.

Section 2. No election shall be held within the city of Stayton, Oregon, or within the territory in Section 1. hereof

described; on the question of annexation of such territory to such city.

Section 3. Whereas existing conditions in the territory annexed to the City of Stayton hereby and in such city are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor, subject, however, to the referendum as provided by law.
