ORDENANCE NO. 116.

An Ordinance establishing a grade line on West Water Street, in the Town of Stayton, Oregon, from its intersection with First Street in said Town, to the West terminus of said Street.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a grade line be and the same is hereby established on West Water Street, in the Town of Stayton, Oregon, described as follows:

Commencing at a point 40 feet West and 25 feet South of the South West corner of Block No. 1 in the Town of Stayton, (That being the center of West Water Street, at its intersection of First Street, at an elevation of 96 feet, taking the door sill of the Brewer Drug Company's Store at 100 and a bench mark on the concrete base of the I. O. O. F. building on 3rd Streed, at a point on the left of the North entrance 6 inches from the concrete side walk and marked with an 'X' cut in said base as Elevation 99.14.

Running thence West in the center of said Street with a down grade of 6-5/8 inches to each 100 feet, for a distance of 900 feet to Elevation 91.50; thence continuing west with an up grade of 3 inches to each 266 feet for a distance of 422 feet to elevation 91.90 feet at the west boundary line of S. H. Burson's Addition to Stayton, Uregon.

Section 2. It is the judgment of this Council that an emergency exists, and that it is necessary for the peace, health and safety of the Town of Stayton, that this Ordinance shall be in force and operation upon its approval by the Mayor.
