

ORDINANCE NO. 139.

A Bill for an Ordinance fixing the amount of official bond required of the Recorder, Marshal and Treasurer; providing for approval and filing of same; and repealing Ordinance No. 61.

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Recorder, Marshal and Treasurer of the town of Stayton, Oregon, shall each, respectively, before entering upon the discharge of their duties, execute to the Town of Stayton, a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$500.00 for the faithful performance of the duties required of them, provided, however, that the Council shall have the right to increase the Treasurer's bond in any sum not to exceed \$2000.00.

Section 2. Said bonds shall be approved by the Council; the bonds of the Marshal and Treasurer shall be fixed with the Recorder; and the bond of the Recorder shall be filed with the Treasurer.

Section 3. That all of Ordinance No. 61 be and the same is hereby repealed.
