

ORDINANCE NO. 158

A Bill for an Ordinance to vacate the street directly east of Block 9, in the U. Whitney's Addition to the Town of Stayton, Oregon, and Whereas, it appears to the Council from the verified petition of S. H. Heitzel that he is the sole owner of the lands adjoining said street and that no other person has any property adjacent to or adjoining said street; and it further appearing from the proofs now on file that due notice as required by law of the pendency of said petition has been given as required by law, and it further appearing to the Council that the interest of the public will not be prejudiced by the granting of said petition, THEREFORE,

THE TOWN OF STAYTON DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That that portion of 7th street lying directly east of Block 9, in the U. Whitney's Addition to the Town of Stayton, Oregon, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Whereas, the vacating of the street above mentioned has been granted in consideration of certain corrections covering the entire U. Whitney Addition wherein valuable property rights were involved including interests of the town of Stayton, it is the judgment of the Council that an emergency exists, and that it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the peace, health and safety of the town that this ordinance become operative immediately upon its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
