ORDINANCE NO. 1001

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STAYTON MUNICIPAL CODE (SMC) TITLE 17, REGARDING MANUFACTURING USES IN DOWNTOWN MIXED USE ZONES

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 197 requires municipalities to adopt and implement a comprehensive land use planning program in accordance with statewide planning goals established by the Legislature and the Oregon Land Conservation and Development Commission;

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton has adopted Title 17 of the Stayton Municipal Code as the Land Use and Development Code;

WHEREAS, Stayton Municipal Code Title 17, Chapter 20, Section 17.16.070 controls the uses in individual zones within the City and currently permits printing and related support activities as the only manufacturing use in the downtown mixed use zones;

WHEREAS, small-scale manufacturing uses can be beneficial in the vitality of the downtown area;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is appropriate to allow small-scale manufacturing uses in the downtown mixed use zones provided there is a retail component to the use;

WHEREAS, the Stayton Planning Commission has initiated the process for amending the Land Use and Development Code and following a public hearing, has recommended that the Stayton City Council enact proposed amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council, following a public hearing, does find that the amendments proposed by the Planning Commission are appropriate.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City of Stayton ordains:

Section 1. SMC Title 17, Chapter 16 amended. Stayton Municipal Code, Title 17, Chapter 16 is hereby amended by changing Table 17.16.070.1 to list Food Manufacturing, Beverage Manufacturing, Textile Mills & Textile Product Mills, Apparel & Leather Manufacturing, Fabricated Metal Product Manufacturing, Furniture & Related Product Manufacturing and Miscellaneous Manufacturing as permitted uses following site plan review in the Central Core Mixed Use, Downtown Commercial Mixed Use, and Downtown Residential Mixed Use zones, with footnote 16 applying to these uses, limiting their size to 8,000 square feet of gross floor area and requiring that a minimum of 15% of their floor area must be for retail sales of products to the public accessible directly from the street.

Section 2. SMC Title 17, Chapter 16 amended. Stayton Municipal Code, Title 17, Chapter 16 is hereby amended by changing Table 17.16.070.1 to list Wood Products Manufacturing as a permitted use following site plan review in the Central Core Mixed Use, Downtown Commercial Mixed Use, and Downtown Residential Mixed Use zones, with footnote 17 applying to these uses to prohibit sawmills and wood preservation, veneer, plywood and engineered wood product

manufacturing, wood container and pallet manufacturing and manufactured home manufacturing.

Section 3. SMC Title 17, Chapter 16 amended. Stayton Municipal Code, Title 17, Chapter 16 is hereby amended by changing footnote 8 in Table 17.16.070.1 as it applies to printing and related support activities to reduce the permitted floor area of these uses from 10,000 square feet to 8,000 square feet.

Section 4. A portion of Table 17.16.070.1 is attached hereto and designated as Exhibit A. and illustrates the changes to the table as described in Sections 1 through 3 above.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective 30 days after adoption by the Stayton City Council and the Mayor's signing.

Section 6. A copy of this Ordinance shall be furnished to the State of Oregon, Department of Land Conservation and Development forthwith.

Notes to Table 17.16.070.1

Fruit and Vegetable Canning, Pickling, Freezing, and Drying only

Required printing or under 10,0008.000 square feet gross floor area
