

ORDINANCE NO. 516

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATES FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE IN THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 496, SECTION 13, EXHIBIT "A"; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The rates to be charged all persons, firms, or corporations shall be reasonable and uniform, taking into consideration the service rendered and shall not be in excess of the following schedule:

Commercial & Residential Can Service once per week:

1 can (32 gallon)	\$	3.75 per month
2nd or additional can		1.75 per month

Industrial Drop Box Rate:

30 yards	\$	2.10 per yard

Container Service:

	1 stop per week	2 stops per week

Section 2. The commercial and residential rates specified in Section 1 of this ordinance are based on government regulations requiring weekly service for putricible solid wastes. The rates are based on a per unit charge for each residential unit or commercial establishment.

Section 3. So long as these rates remain in effect, the franchise holder shall be permitted to adopt reasonable rules, with prior written approval of the chairman of the solid waste committee, for the pick up of solid wastes on the driveway, curb or elsewhere, although special consideration shall be given for aged or infirm

persons, and the maximum rates described herein shall not prohibit the franchise holder from billing in advance.


Section 4. Section 13 of Ordinance No. 496 is hereby amended to read:

"Section 13. The rates to be charged for hauling garbage shall be as contained in Ordinance No. ____ of the City of Stayton as amended".

Section 5. This ordinance being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
