## ORDINANCE NO. 526

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 512 AND ADOPTING THE STAYTON COMPREHENSIVE PLAN, AS AMENDED.

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes provides for cities to develop Comprehensive Land Use Plans consistent with State-wide Goals, and;

WHEREAS, the Land Conservation and Development Commission has recommended certain amendments to the Comprehensive Plan pursuant to the acknowledgement process, and;

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton and its residents have, through a series of public workshops, developed amendments to the Comprehensive Plan, which amendments have been integrated into the Plan document,

NOW THEREFORE

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Adoption of the Stayton Comprehensive Plan as Amended.

The City of Stayton hereby adopts by reference that certain document as amended by the City Council entitled "Comprehensive Plan, Stayton Urban Area" that the City received on January 4, 1980, and ordered placed on file for public inspection in the office of the Administrator, and that has since continuously been so on file and available for public inspection during regular working hours.
