ORDINANCE NO. 550

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING ASSESSMENTS ON PROPERTY BENEFITTED FOR THE COST OF CONSTRUCTION OF A SIDEWALK ON HIGHLAND DRIVE.

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council ordered in a sidewalk on the northwest side of Highland Drive fronting Lots 4 and 5, Block 6, Highland Estates No. 2; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Code, the benefitting property owners were notified and directed to construct the sidewalk within 60 days; and

WHEREAS, the benefitting owners did not so construct the sidewalk and the City, pursuant to Code, caused the sidewalk to be constructed and is now obliged to assess the benefitted property owners their proportionate share of the cost, such total cost being \$3,028.70.

NOW THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF STAYTON ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Assessment Formula

Assessments will be on a front foot basis abutting Highland Drive, each parcel being assessed that portion of the total cost of the sidewalk which its frontage bears to the total frontage. The cost of a driveway approach shall be assessed to that specifically benefitted property.
