## **RESOLUTION NO. 426**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXERCISE OF ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES BY THE POLICE CHIEF.

WHEREAS, Stayton Ordinance Number 667, Section 7.105, authorizes the exercise of specific administrative duties by the Police Chief;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON resolves as follows:

- <u>SECTION 1</u>: From the effective date of this Resolution, the Chief of Police or his designate shall exercise the following duties:
  - 1. Implement ordinances, resolutions, and motions of the Council regarding traffic control devices. Installation shall be based on standards contained in <u>The</u> <u>Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets</u> and Highways and the Oregon Supplements.
  - 2. Temporarily establish, remove, or alter the following classes of traffic controls:
    - a. Crosswalks, safety zones, and traffic lanes;
    - Intersection channelization and areas where vehicle drivers shall not make right, left, or Uturns, and the time when the prohibition applies;
    - c. Parking areas and time limitations including the form of permissible parking (e.g., parallel or diagonal).
  - 3. Issue oversize or overweight vehicle permits.
  - Temporarily close or block streets.

<u>SECTION 2</u>: This Resolution is shall take full force and effect on 20 December 1989.
