

RESOLUTION NO. 426

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXERCISE OF ADMINISTRATIVE DUTIES BY THE POLICE CHIEF.

WHEREAS, Stayton Ordinance Number 667, Section 7.105, authorizes the exercise of specific administrative duties by the Police Chief;

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON resolves as follows:

SECTION 1: From the effective date of this Resolution, the Chief of Police or his designate shall exercise the following duties:

1. Implement ordinances, resolutions, and motions of the Council regarding traffic control devices. Installation shall be based on standards contained in The Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways and the Oregon Supplements.
2. Temporarily establish, remove, or alter the following classes of traffic controls:
 - a. Crosswalks, safety zones, and traffic lanes;
 - b. Intersection channelization and areas where vehicle drivers shall not make right, left, or U-turns, and the time when the prohibition applies;
 - c. Parking areas and time limitations including the form of permissible parking (e.g., parallel or diagonal).
3. Issue oversize or overweight vehicle permits.
4. Temporarily close or block streets.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is shall take full force and effect on 20 December 1989.
