RESOLUTION NUMBER 152

ORDERING CONSTRUCTION OF CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND STORM SEWERS ON BOTH SIDES OF GARDNER AVENUE FROM THE NORTH SIDE OF WEST WASHINGTON STREET TO THE SOUTH SIDE OF SHAFF ROAD.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it to be necessary and expedient that Gardner Avenue from the North side of West Washington Street to the South side of Shaff Road, within the City of Stayton, be improved by construction of a storm drainage system, of a curb and four foot sidewalk along the East side, and of a five foot curb-sidewalk along the West side of said Gardner Avenue.

The curbs, sidewalks and storm sewers ordered constructed by this resolution shall be built of Portland cement concrete as provided by Ordinance No. 300 and shall be laid down and constructed at the expense of the lot or parcel of land involved. The storm sewer system along Gardner Avenue and the curb-sidewalk along the West side of said Avenue shall be completed within 90 days, and the curb and sidewalk along the East side of said Avenue shall be completed within 120 days, after engineering data is available and notice is given to the owners.

The Recorder shall give notice by mail to the owner of said property requiring such owner to construct a curb, sidewalks and storm sewers as herein ordered; and in case the address of the owner be unknown, the City Engineer shall post such notice upon said property. Before constructing such curbs, sidewalks and storm sewer system, the owner of said premises or his agent shall obtain plans and specifications from the City Engineer, which shall prescribe the kind of curbs, sidewalks and storm sewers to be constructed, the material to be used and specifications therefor.

In case the owner of the property shall fail to construct the curb, sidewalks and storm sewers as hereby ordered, and within the

time limit above specified, the Common Council shall take steps to a bring about the construction of such improvements and make the cost thereof a lien upon the property involved.
