RESOLUTION NO. 178

ORDERING PAVING OF 6TH AVENUE BETWEEN HOLLISTER AND ROBIDOUX STREETS

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON:

The Common Council hereby declares it necessary and expedient that 6th Avenue between Hollister and Robidoux Streets, within the City of Stayton, be improved by grading such street to proper subgrade and by surfacing the right of way with asphaltic concrete.

Said improvements are to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Stayton, and in accordance with the grades, plans and specifications of the City Engineer.

The cost of such improvement in excess of \$3.75 per front foot of property shall be borne by the City of Stayton. The costs incurred up to and including \$3.75 per front foot shall be levied against the property abutting said street and benefitted thereby and shall constitute a lien against said property as provided by the Charter of the City of Stayton.

The City Recorder shall give notice of the intention to construct said street paving improvements to the owners of the abutting properties as provided by the City Charter. Said street paving improvements shall be completed within sixty days from the date of mailing said notice of intention to construct.
