
RESOLUTION TO EXCEED 6% LIMITATION

Whereas it appears necessary to the city council of the Town of Stayton that a proper operation of the city affairs for the fiscal period July 1, 1958 to June 30, 1959, will require \$6,764.00 more in tax revenues than the city is authorized to raise by taxation within the limitation contained in Article XI, Section 11, of the constitution of Oregon,

Now, therefore, it is hereby resolved by the council of the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon that the proposition hereinafter set forth be submitted to the legal voters of said Town of Stayton at a special election to be held on May 16, 1958, from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the regular polling places, and that notice thereof be given by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, not less than ten (10) days before said election and that notices thereof be posted in three public places within said Town of Stayton. Said proposition shall be as follows:


In the fiscal period July 1, 1958 to June 30, 1959, the council of the Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon is authorized to levy a tax of \$6,764.00 for the purpose of proper operation of city affairs which tax is to be outside the limitation on taxation set forth in Article XI, Section 11, of the Constitution of Oregon.
