At a regular meeting of the Council of the City of Stayton, Oregon, held in the Council Chambers in the City Hall in said city on October 3, 1966, the following resolution was regularly adopted:

## RESOLUTION NO. 96

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Stayton in Marion County, Oregon, that the following proposed amendments to the Charter of the City of Stayton in Marion County, Oregon, be and the same hereby are submitted under the ballot titles shown thereunder to the legal voters of such city for their adoption or rejection at a special city election hereby called to be held in such city on Tuesday, November 8, 1966.

## MEASURE NO. 1

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS BY THE CITY COUNCIL

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the City of Stayton, Oregon, by repealing paragraphs 9 and 10 of Section 8, and all of Sections 9, 10, and 11, of Chapter IV of such Charter, relating to bond issues of such city that have been fully paid and retired.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON

Section 1. Paragraphs 9 and 10 of Section 8, and all of Sections 9, 10, and 11, of Chapter IV of the Charter of the City of Stayton, Oregon, relating to bond issues of such city that have been fully paid and retired, are repealed.

Section 2. The ballot title for such measure, prepared by the city attorney and approved by the council, shall be as follows:

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS BY THE CITY COUNCIL

Shall the Charter of the City of Stayton, Oregon, be amended by repealing paragraphs 9 and 10 of Section 8, and all of Sections 9, 10, and 11, of Chapter IV of such Charter relating to bond issues of such city that have been fully paid and retired?

## MEASURE NO. 2

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS BY THE CITY COUNCIL

AN ACT to amend Chapter VII, Section 6, of the Charter of the City of Stayton, Oregon, by eliminating therefrom the 5 percent that the Council is authorized thereby to add to the actual costs of street improvements, to pay engineering expenses, to acquire descriptions of property, and to meet other special expenses connected with the making of such improvements, and authorizing the Council to add, instead of the said 5 percent, such percentage to the actual costs of such improvements as it shall deem reasonable and sufficient for such purposes?

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF STAYTON, OREGON

Section 1. Chapter VII, Section 6, of the Charter of the City of Stayton, Oregon, is amended to read:

Chapter VII, Section 6. In case the notice be for improvement of a street or part thereof, and the same shall not have been defeated by remonstrance, as provided in Section 4, the council shall direct the mayor and recorder of the city to enter into a contract with the person, persons, firm or corporation submitting the lowest bid as hereinbefore provided, to make said improvement, and shall require any such contractor to execute a good and sufficient bond and undertaking in a sum equal to the amount of the contract price, conditioned to make said improvement according to the plans and specifications, and according to the terms and conditions of such contract, and to complete the same within such reasonable time as shall be determined by the council. After such contract and bond are executed and the council has thereby ascertained and determined the actual cost of such improvement, including a percentage of such contract price deemed by the council to be reasonable and sufficient for engineering expenses, acquiring descriptions of property, and other special expenses connected with making such improvement, the council shall assess upon each lot or part thereof liable therefor, its proportionate share of such costs; provided, however, that the council shall have the right to reject any and all bids for any of said proposed improvements.

Section 2. The ballot title for such measure, prepared by the city attorney and approved by the council, shall be as follows:

CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS BY THE CITY COUNCIL

Shall Chapter VII, Section 6, of the Charter of the City of Stayton, Oregon, be amended by eliminating therefrom the 5 percent that the council is authorized thereby to add to the actual costs of street improvements,

to pay engineering expenses, to acquire descriptions of property, and to meet other special expenses connected with the making of such improvements, and authorizing the council to add, instead of the said 5 percent, such percentage to the actual costs of such improvements as it shall deem reasonable and sufficient for such purposes?

RESOLVED FURTHER that this resolution be filed with the Recorder of the City of Stayton for submission of the foregoing proposed Charter Amendments to the legal voters of such city for their approval or rejection at a special city election hereby called to be held on Tuesday, the 8th day of November, 1966, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m. on such date.

RESOLVED FURTHER that the polling places and judges and clerks of election for such election shall be the same as for the statewide general election held on such date, and that the Recorder be and he hereby is instructed to post and publish notices of such election in the manner provided by Ordinance Numbered 242 of such city, and to furnish to the election boards for such election, the necessary records, ballots, ballot boxes, tally sheets, and supplies.

RESOLVED FURTHER that such election shall be conducted in accordance with the election laws of the state of Oregon and the ordinances of the City of Stayton, Oregon, and that upon approval by the voters of such proposed Charter Amendments the Mayor shall issue his Proclamation of the adoption thereof.
