RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the Town of Stayton, did upon the proper filing of petitions call a special election for submitting the proposition of annexation to the Town of Stayton, both to the voters of the Town and the voters of the area proposed to be annexed (Eastgate) and said election was called for the 19th day of May, 1950:

WHEREAS, and pursuant to a resolution passed by the Common Council of the Town of Stayton, notices were posted and published calling said election and said election was held on the 19th day of May, 1950, and the results of said election were canvassed and transcribed on the 20th day of May, 1950, and the results of said election were as follows: Total votes cast in Town of Stayton, 421; Votes Yes, 348, Votes No 73; Total votes cast in area proposed to be annexed (Eastgate), 36, Votes Yes 24, Votes No 12;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that based upon the annexation election results of May, 19, 1950, and the canvass thereof as of May 20, 1950, the following described real property and area is hereby annexed to and made a part of the corporate Town of Stayton, Marion County, Oregon, to-wit:

Beginning at a point 1980 feet North of the Southwest corner of Section 11, Township 9 South Range 1 West of the Willamette Meridian in Marion County, Oregon; thence running East 1320 feet; thence running North 1650 feet; thence running West 1320 feet; thence South 1650 feet to the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the gity Recorder of the Town of Stayton be and he is hereby directed to cause a copy of this daid resolution together with a transcript of the result of the vote in said election to be forwarded to Hon. Earl T. Newbry, Secretary of State, H. A. Judd, Marion County, Clerk, and R. (Tad) Shelton, Marion County Tax Assessor.
