

RESOLUTION NO. 1041

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SIGN A CONTRACT WITH PIXEL SECURITY FOR SAFETY AND SECURITY UPGRADES AT CITY FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, in 2021, the City was awarded one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) in Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund Grant funds for improving the safety and security of City of Stayton facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City developed a scope and requested bids from three reputable companies to add cameras and door access control to the following city-owned buildings: City Hall, Police Department, Municipal Court, PW Maintenance Shops, and Community Center; and

WHEREAS, Pixel Security was the lowest bid and the only one of the three bids submitted within the perimeters of the grant funds available; and

WHEREAS, the City staff and IT consultant Jeff Heyen believe that the bid from Pixel Security of \$86,925.21 is a solid bid that will result in the requested improvements being completed in a professional and competent manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Manager or her designee, is authorized to sign a contract with Pixel Security in the amount of \$86,925.21 and may sign additional contract amendments, if needed for contingency, up to the grant amount of \$100,000.

SECTION 2. The scope of the work included in the contract shall be consistent with the bid provided and included as Exhibit A to this resolution.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.
