

Emergency Sirens For City of Stayton

To the City of Stayton, City counselors, and budget committee. This is a request to add City of Stayton Sirens to Emergency budget. During the wildfires of 2020, there was not an emergency plan in place to notify citizens of the encroaching wildfire (which, luckily, did not come into Stayton). My son came from Salem to wake us up and evacuate us at 3AM. He found out when his mother-in-law evacuated to his house from Lyons. I called many people that needed to get out of the danger area. I also called my Pastor and had him ring the church bells.

Since then I have been asking people about reinstalling the sirens we used to have to call the volunteer firemen to fires. Everyone knows there is an emergency when they hear a siren. It is the fastest way to notify the community. If we had a siren on each of the public schools, the firehall, City hall/Police Dept and also reinact the siren on top of the water tower. That would pretty much cover the whole City of Stayton.

I talked to at least 5 sound companies, but was unable to get a bid on the work. I would imagine it would be about \$20,000 to \$30,000. I tried to call all the counselors and when that failed emailed proposal to them so they could ask questions or discuss this before the meeting.

We could at any time have an emergency. either another wildfire, or a landslide spilling water over the dam's lip, a tornado, chemical spill. etc. Not everyone has a phone on them at all times, most turn off at night, people working outside, walking shopping biking. They all need to be warned.

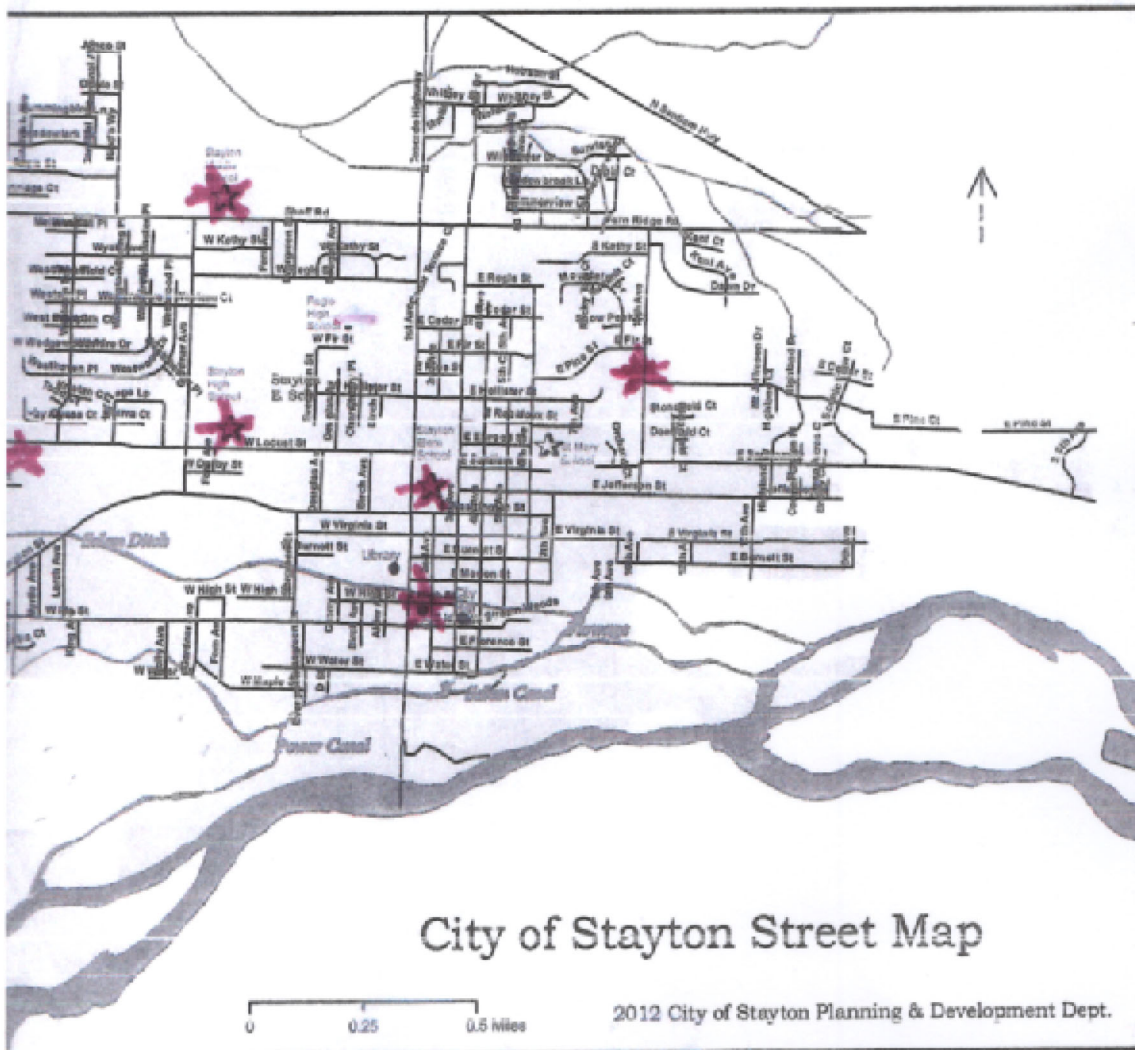
Please at least put this on as a budget item. I tried to call all the counselors, and not being successful, also tried to email information to them. My email addresses were not good, many were returned.

I am reaching out to inform you of my plan to present an Emergency plan putting sirens on all the public schools, the City Hall/Police Dept and the Stayton Firehall. I understand the City still owns a system on the water tower. Years ago the city had sirens to notify the volunteer firemen. Everyone knows a siren means something not normal is happening.

During the wildfires of 2020, there was not notification that I am aware of to the citizens of Stayton, My son came from Salem to awake us at 3:00 Am after his mother-in-law evacuated to his house from Lyons. There was no real way to notify the public up the canyon and also Stayton. We could get more wildfires, floods, tonadoess, chemical spills, or even reach to Detroit dam due to a landslide from burned out forests sliding into reservoir and pushing water over the lip of the dam.

I have talked to many people in Stayton about this, I found a lot of desire for this method. Just depending on the current plan of reverse 911 does not take in fact that most people have phones off during night, and many people do not have a phone in their bedroom. Lots of people do not have phone available for many outdoor activities. Since there has not been any practice emergency in Stayton we do not know how well it would work.

Everyone everywhere understands a siren means emergency. No language barriers there.
