To Stayton city council members or to who it may concern:

I am writing to you today in regards to the proposed fee schedule for the Stayton Family Memorial Pool. I notice that some of the fees have risen to almost 4 times the amount that they were before the pool closure, and I am concerned that that much of a price increase will make using the pool unaffordable to the average Stayton Family. At \$238 dollars per month for my family of four, each of us would have to use the pool daily to make that worth it and that's just not feasible, even if we could afford to pay that. I don't live in Stayton City limits, but I am a Stayton resident and my family shops and plays in Stayton as much as we can. We championed for the passing of the levy because we understand and appreciate the value that the SFMP brings to the community. I understand that running and maintaining a pool is expensive, but it was difficult to get this levy passed and I believe that with this high of a price increase there is no way local residents will ever be onboard with passing another levy in the future. I am also concerned about the amount of Stayton families that will even be able to afford to use the pool on a regular basis. Please consider a more reasonable fee schedule so that SFMP can thrive and Stayton residents can afford and enjoy the use of this wonderful establishment.
