

## RESOLUTION NO. 25-011 ESTABLISHING PUBLIC ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE STAYTON SAFETY ACTION PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton was awarded federal funding of \$120,000 as part of the FY 2023 Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program administered by the Federal Highway Administration;

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Stayton Safety Action Plan (SSAP) is to identify and prioritize strategies to enhance the safety of all transportation modes throughout the City of Stayton;

WHEREAS, the Stayton City Council recognizes the importance of public engagement in developing the SSAP and seeks to establish a Public Advisory Committee (PAC) to provide guidance and oversight throughout the planning process until the plan is finalized and adopted by the Stayton City Council; and

WHEREAS, the PAC will be a body of up to nine members composed of:

- One (1) member of the Planning Commission;
- One (1) member of the Parks Board;
- Two (2) members of the Stayton City Council;
- One (1) bicycle enthusiast;
- One (1) pedestrian enthusiast;
- One (1) member of the school board or District;
- Two (2)other interested citizen of the City of Stayton;

WHEREAS, representation from existing groups shall be determined by the body of said group, with other representatives selected by the Mayor; and

WHEREAS, In the event not all positions are able to be filled, a quorum shall be a majority of appointed members as opposed to potential members.

## NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF STAYTON RESOLVES:

- **SECTION 1.** The City of Stayton hereby establishes the Public Advisory Committee (PAC) to oversee the development of the Stayton Safety Action Plan.
- **SECTION 2.** The PAC shall remain active until the Stayton Safety Action Plan is finalized and adopted by the Stayton City Council.
- **SECTION 4.** The PAC shall provide recommendations and feedback to the City Council and City staff to ensure the Stayton Safety Action Plan reflects community needs and priorities.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.
