RESOLUTION NO. 25-012 AWARDING FY 2024 – 2025 STAYTON COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT GRANTS

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton budgeted \$14,587 in the 2024-25 fiscal year to fund the Community Improvement Grant program;

WHEREAS, the goals of the 2024-25 Stayton Community Improvement Grant Program are to enhance neighborhood livability, support services for residents, and foster collaboration among community members;

WHEREAS, the application period for the grant program was open from February 1, 2025, to March 28, 2025, and the grant program was advertised and applications were accepted from businesses, non-profit organizations, and neighborhood groups working on projects benefiting the Stayton community;

WHEREAS, nine (9) project applications were received, requesting a total of \$37,775, exceeding the available funding; and

WHEREAS, a five-member staff committee evaluated and ranked the applications based on alignment with program goals, community impact, demonstrated support, and measurable outcomes, with their findings presented for discussion at the work session.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF STAYTON RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The Stayton Community Improvement Grant Program for the 2024-25 fiscal year is hereby approved, with funding allocations based on established criteria and Council determination.

SECTION 2. The Council authorizes the distribution of available grant funds to the following projects with corresponding grant fund amounts:
