

RESOLUTION NO. 25-013

SUPPORTING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OREGON TRANSPORTATION AND GROWTH MANAGEMENT PROGRAM FOR A DOWNTOWN PARKING REFORM AND MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton is committed to fostering a vibrant and thriving downtown area that supports local businesses, improves transportation options, and addresses the needs of residents and visitors; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the need for a comprehensive evaluation of its downtown parking conditions to ensure that available parking is being utilized efficiently and that future parking demands are met; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to explore innovative parking reform strategies to improve parking availability, including the potential development of a parking management plan for the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that the Transportation and Growth Management (TGM)
Program, administered by the Oregon Department of Land Conservation and Development, offers a valuable opportunity for technical assistance and funding to support this critical planning effort; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to apply for assistance to assess current parking conditions, identify parking needs, and develop specific strategies for increasing parking opportunities within the existing street system in downtown; and

WHEREAS, it is recognized a financial match is not required, however local staff must actively participate and support the project.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF STAYTON RESOLVES:

- SECTION 1. The City Council expresses its full support for the submission of a grant application to the Oregon Transportation and Growth Management Program for the Downtown Parking Reform and Management Plan.
- **SECTION 2.** The City Council authorizes the City Manager or her designee to complete and submit the grant application.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.
