



RESOLUTION NO. 25-038
COMMUNITY IMPROVEMENT GRANT 2025–2026 – FINAL ALLOCATIONS

WHEREAS, the City of Stayton budgeted \$20,000 for the 2025–26 fiscal year to fund the Community Improvement Grant program;

WHEREAS, the goals of the 2025-26 Stayton Community Improvement Grant Program are to enhance neighborhood livability, support services for residents, and foster collaboration among community members;

WHEREAS, the application period for the grant program was open from September 18, 2025, to October 24, 2025, and the grant program was advertised, and applications were accepted from businesses, non-profit organizations, and neighborhood groups working on projects benefiting the Stayton community;

WHEREAS, the fourteen (14) project applications were received, requesting a total of \$57,072, exceeding the available funding; and

WHEREAS, a staff committee evaluated and ranked the applications based on alignment with program goals, community impact, demonstrated support, and measurable outcomes, with their findings presented for discussion at the work session.

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY OF STAYTON RESOLVES:

SECTION 1. The Stayton Community Improvement Grant Program for the 2024-25 fiscal year is hereby approved, with funding allocations based on established criteria and Council determination.

SECTION 2. The Council authorizes the distribution of available grant funds to the following projects with corresponding grant fund amounts:

Project Name	Short Description	Grant Ask
Table Tennis Pioneer Park	Install outdoor table tennis and corn hole games at Pioneer Park to encourage community recreation and connection.	\$4,825.01
Santiam Teen Center	Improve Santiam Teen Center's accessibility by weatherizing and securing its ADA ramp and outdoor deck.	\$1,100
Flowing Through Time II	Add three new mural areas celebrating Stayton's history, Kalapuya heritage, and community creativity in downtown's Flowing Through Time series.	\$4,350
Brown House Landscape Maintenance	Restore and maintain Brown House landscaping with professional weeding, trimming, composting, and bark application.	\$2,000
Spotlight Community Theater Safety	Upgrade Spotlight Theater's lighting and install an ADA sink to improve safety, accessibility, and performance quality.	\$4,945.21

Saving Lives	Provide free community training in CPR, AED use, first aid, and emergency response to save lives.	\$2,000
North Santiam Service Integration	Support North Santiam Service Integration Team providing emergency aid and essential services to vulnerable Stayton residents.	\$1,200

SECTION 3. The approved grant recipients must submit a project summary upon completion, including photographs or printed materials, along with a financial report detailing the use of grant funds.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption by the Stayton City Council.
