- Threaten to arrest you unless you wire money/purchase gift cards

Vacancies on City of Stayton Boards, Commissions, and Committees

Make a Difference in Our Community

The City of Stayton is looking for individuals to serve on the following Boards, Commissions, and Committees:

- Parks and Recreation Board (1 vacancy)



The Parks and Recreation Board is responsible for developing, maintaining parks, recreation programs and serves as an advisory board to the City Council.

- Public Arts Commission (1 vacancy)



The purpose of the Commission is to promote educational, cultural, economic and general welfare of Stayton by actively pursuing the placement of public art in public spaces within Stayton city limits while also serving to preserve and develop public access to the arts. The Commission is responsible for assisting the Council and other City boards and commissions in using public art to enhance existing development in public parks, and other public lands, and in public structures.

- Budget Committee (2 vacancies)



The Budget Committee meets every two years to review and approve the biennial budget. Typically, there are three meetings in May/June of odd numbered years and one meeting in August/September of even numbered years for a status update.

Serving on a City board, commission, or committee is great way to share your ideas and help shape local decisions.

All month long


Test out different art techniques in miniature, and either take them home or put them on display. New suggestions and materials will be available each week, all month long!
