May 19, 2026 Election STAYTON PARKS AND POOL LEVY

What is the Parks and Pool Levy?

The Parks and Pool Levy (levy) will help to fund parks and pool operations in the City of Stayton for five years, beginning in fiscal year 2026-2027.

The levy rate is \$0.985 per \$1,000 of Assessed Value (AV).

The levy replaces the existing levy that expires on June 30, 2026. The five year operating levy will enable maintaining current levels of service and operations for the City's 11 parks and natural areas as well as the Stayton Family Memorial Pool.




FACILITY RENTALS




