



So a few points to think about and possibly discuss on Monday.

1. My and Steve Spangler wetland presentation/request should have nothing to do with Barry's grand vision of city ownership of Lucas ditch basin. I agree with city ownership, but my request was very specific and LONG before he started this venture.
2. Repeated emails to public works and city director were sent asking for status updates in the months following my presentation and guided tour date . They were largely ignored. I would be happy to share with you or anyone those emails and a detailed timeline.
3. The April 20 agenda item 3 states there will be an update on Lucas ditch and sylvan springs storm water facility. Since Julia and other staff want to make sure we stay extremely procedural, and emails from concerned and well informed citizens are not allowed then 1. It is NOT sylvan springs. They are the neighborhood to the west. They have zero to do with this. I am representing the village at sylvan springs. A very important distinction 2. I have issue with the term facility. That to me implies some sort of building with moving parts that needs to be serviced/maintained daily. That is a subtle mis definition. It is a structure. More to the point, it's a big hole in the ground with a concrete weir to slow the water drainage. And it works perfectly as long as the city does not have obstructions downstream.
4. Why has the council not asked about follow up on my presentation? If council is waiting for my response to public works insane proposal of \$250,000, let's readdress "procedure". Under no thought process was my proposal to council also directed at public works. I feel strongly that council should inact due diligence and ask public works opinions and ask for data to make an informed decision. Therefore, a point of order here. I feel it was not accurate procedure for public works to come to a private citizens house to present a \$250,000 budget. That should have been done in council. Which apparently it was, and I was not told about it therefore not present. To be perfectly clear, the village at sylvan springs will not engage in any type of conversation or financial debate with public works. If council wants to ask myself or Steve Spangler about their proposed numbers and our actual expenses, we will be happy to answer any and all questions. I may be wrong, but I feel that council is waiting for a response to public works proposal.
