Dear Alissa,

I am unsure as to where the decision-making process is at this time with regard to the Stayton Memorial Pool being able to remain open to the area. As you know it is the only pool in our area given that none of the schools have a pool.

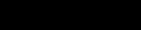
Several weeks ago, I contacted Freres lumber to ask about the possibility of pool support.

I was referred to the Oregon Community Foundation where a Freres family member has created a fund committed to the area served by the pool, so I thought it worth inquiring. Given that the Wipper fund only supports children I was advised to pull out the percentage of usage by children from the total usage. I met Howard Tsang and sent him my questions. He supplied me with information last Thursday which I summarized in the attachment below just to show pool usage by in area and out of area.

While there is consideration for raising membership costs for out of area folks I think that given the amount of out of area usage this warrants careful consideration. I live out of the area and am in favor of raising prices to help but just want it to be realistic so we do not lose patrons for lack of payment ability.

I contacted the Oregon Community Foundation (OCF) per the suggestion of the Freres family. OCF manages the Doris Wipper fund which is an advised fund that supports youth and adolescents in the **region that the pool serves. While there is no guarantee of support, more information is needed to approach the Wipper funds. Doris Wipper was a beloved Freres family member who established this fund in support of healthy children in our area. If helpful, I will continue to work with city staff in this regard.

The primary service area of the Doris J. Wipper Fund is Marion County, Oregon, with a heavy concentration on Stayton and the Santiam Canyon region; specifically targeting:

Aumsville, Detroit, Gates, Idanha, Lyons, Mehama, Mill City, Stayton, and Sublimity

Looking at the numbers in the council packet for tonight and the numbers in the article in Our Town Civics 101 July 2026, page 6

The article, quoting from Howard says pool fund grows to \$138k... awesome...the packet numbers are more optimisting

Based on the \$375,000 goal, with the Our Town Figure of \$138,000 raised we are still \$237,000 short of the goal

Based on the \$375,000 goal, with the numbers presented in the council packet, of \$328,027, we are still short of goal \$46,973

Not to be a wet blanket, but, from very recent experience in a campaign, somewhere between 1/3 and 1/2 the pledges did not become reality
