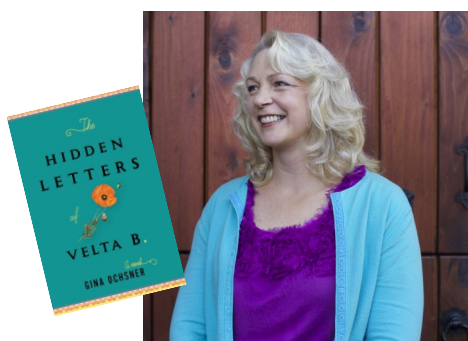

Gina Ochsner lives in Keizer, Oregon and teaches writing and literature at Corban University and with Seattle Pacific's Low Residency MFA program. She is the author of the short story collection *The Necessary Grace to Fall*, which was selected for the Flannery O'Connor Award and the collection *People I*



Wanted to Be. Both collections received the Oregon Book Award. In 2010 Houghton Mifflin Harcourt released *The Russian Dreambook of Color and Flight*. Her latest novel entitled *The Hidden Letters of Velta B* was released in July 2016; the

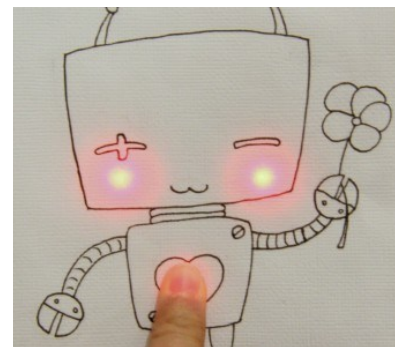
